

I. CALL TO ORDER/FLAG SALUTE

The July 18, 2018 Special Public Meeting of the Edison Board of Education was called to order by Board President, Mr. Jingwei (Jerry) Shi, at 6:00 P.M. at the Education Center, 312 Pierson Avenue, Edison, NJ 08837.

II. ROLL CALL

VII. RESOLUTIONS

A. APPOINTMENT OF INTERIM SUPERINTENDENT

WHEREAS, the Edison Township Board of Education has the need for a qualified individual to perform the duties of Interim Superintendent during its ongoing search for a permanent employee to the position, and has the authority to make the appointment of a temporary officer in the position pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:16-1.1 statutory duty to employ a Superintendent of Schools; and

WHEREAS, Paul Saxton agrees to serve in that position, subject to negotiating a mutually agreeable contract.

NOW, THEREFORE,
BE IT RESOLVED: as follows:

1. The Board hereby approves the appointment of Paul Saxton to the position of Interim Superintendent for the period of August 3, 2018, or as soon thereafter as possible, through June 30, 2019, subject to the Executive County Superintendent Approval of an Interim Superintendent Contract. Paul Saxton shall continue in this position for this term subject to the provisions of Termination as follows.
2. The Board agrees that this appointment, if approved, may be terminated:
 - (i) The Board upon sixty (60) days' written notice to Interim Superintendent;
 - (ii) By Interim Superintendent upon sixty (60) days' written notice to the Board President and Board Secretary;
 - (iii) The Board without the previously mentioned notice for substantiated inefficiency, incapacity, unbecoming conduct, or other just cause;
 - (iv) In the event that Interim Superintendent's certificate is revoked, this Agreement shall become null and void as of the effective date of the revocation; or
 - (v) Mutual agreement of the parties.
3. The Board hereby authorizes the Board President and Board Counsel to negotiate a contract with Paul Saxton for a per diem rate not to exceed the maximum salary allowable by law and to submit the contract to the County Superintendent for approval.
4. The Interim Superintendent appointment shall be subject to ratification by the full Board after the final contract is approved by the County Superintendent.
