VII. <u>BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR/BOARD SECRETARY</u>

Executive Summary Regarding ETEA Negotiations

Mr. Michaud reported that on March 22, 2010 he was appointed by Mr. Dickinson as the Committee to negotiate with the ETEA regarding a salary freeze for the 2010-2011 school year. During the Edison Board of Education public action meeting on March 23, 2010, ETEA President, Emil Ferlicchi, provided a proposal to him for a salary guide freeze that was shared only with Mr. Maeroff and Ms. Szilagyi, due to conflicts of the balance of the Board members.

A negotiations session commenced on March 24, 2010 at the Education Center, attended by Mr. Ferlicchi, Mr. Jeff Bowden, Mr. Matt Hrevnak and Mr. Michaud. The ETEA proposal included a giveback by the teachers and conditions on the Board in order for the salary freeze to take place, which was not in the best interest of the board or the taxpayers. As such, Mr. Michaud noted that he could not recommend the ETEA Proposal to the Board.

Mr. Michaud requested the ETEA to consider the salary guide freeze without the conditions, and the response was that it would not be considered.

VIII. PUBLIC COMMENTS - PROPOSED BUDGET CUTS 2010-2011 (Items 1-49 Attached List)

There were over 700 people in attendance at this Budget Hearing. Many parents were concerned about the elimination of the Paraprofessionals. Some parents were concerned about the elimination of full-day kindergarten and many staff members were concerned about losing their jobs.

Mr. Emil Ferlicchi, ETEA President, discussed the negotiations with Mr. Michaud regarding a proposed wage freeze.

IX. BOARD COMMENTS - PROPOSED BUDGET CUTS 2010-2011 (Items 1-49 Attached List)

The board members also expressed their concerns regarding numerous cuts to the 2010-2011 school budget.
