

I. CALL TO ORDER/FLAG SALUTE

The June 24, 2013 Public Meeting of the Edison Board of Education was called to order by Board President, Mr. Gene I. Maeroff, at 7:00 P.M. at the James Madison Primary School, 840 New Dover Road, Edison, NJ.

II. ROLL CALL

III. OPENING STATEMENT

Mr. Maeroff read the following opening statement:

“The New Jersey Open Public Meetings Law was enacted to insure the right of the public to have advance notice of and to attend the meetings of public bodies at which any business affecting their interests is discussed or acted upon.

In accordance with the provisions of this act, the Edison Board of Education has caused notice of this meeting to be published by having the date, time and place thereof posted in the Board of Education Administrative Offices. Copies of these notices were sent to the Home News and Tribune and the Star Ledger on April 25, 2013.

The Public may participate at regular meetings in accordance with the By-Laws and the applicable State regulations.

IV. JAMES MADISON PRIMARY SCHOOL PRESENTIATION – BANINDER MAHABIR, PRINCIPAL

Ms. Mahabir honored counselor, Lia Abernathy for being an exceptional and valuable member of the JMP family. Students and teachers alike often begin their day in Mrs. Abernathy's office to discuss something that is bothering them. To seek advice or to figure out how to handle a situation. This steady stream of visitors does not stop until the last bus has driven away at the end of the day. Despite this, somehow, she manages to squeeze in time for social groups, lunches to recognize students, individual sessions, helping with character education initiatives, the role of the school HIB liaison and I&RS coordinator, helping parents with structure and parenting techniques at home, as well as any crisis situations that arise during the course of the day.

Mrs. Abernathy creates lasting relationships with students. She considers their individual needs in order to come up with plans and approaches that help them to be prepared to learn. She works with them on strategies that help them to be able to become independent. Her focus is on how they can be self-reliant and think about what actions they can take to self-regulate, calm themselves and mediate conflicts. Her lessons are ones that are important for life.

Mrs. Abernathy's care and concern for each and every student is evident, and it is because of her dedication that we honor her today.

Ms. Mahabir also recognized Ellen Baxter, the case manager for all the students with needs at JMP. Her strength is in the way that she approaches every situation, with calmness and empathy. It is because of this that she is able to connect easily with parents and build relationships based on trust. Mrs. Baxter provides her parents with a clear and understandable picture of their student’s progress and goals all while providing a forum for parents to also give input. She is patient and thoughtful in her manner, and she makes sure to always include rationales to her recommendations.

Mrs. Baxter is not only helpful to the parents, but serves as a resource to all staff members in the building. She is at JMP three days a week, and during that time, her makeshift office is always full. Special education teachers come by to discuss strategies for helping students in their content areas, Special Education teachers come to discuss concerns, occupational, physical and speech therapists stop in to update her and parents come to find out how to best help their children at home.

Knowing that they have her support gives our teachers a level of comfort that allows them to try out new things. When they do implement their ideas, Mrs. Baxter often stops into their classroom to see how things are going, to provide feedback and to cheer on the students.

JMP is extremely lucky to have Mrs. Baxter as part of the staff and to be honored today.

XI. COMMITTEE REPORTS

1. Finance & Facilities Committee

Dr. Heelan reported that the Committee met on May 31, 2013 at the Education Center.

In attendance were: Mr. Gene I. Maeroff, Mrs. Deborah A. Anes, Mrs. Lori A. Bonderowitz, Dr. Frank Heelan, Dr. Richard O'Malley, Mrs. Daniel P. Michaud, Architects Tom Rienzi and Frank Messineo.

Discussion:

- Mr. Michaud gave the results of the three bid openings for 5/30/13 for the Herbert Hoover Middle School locker rooms, the Herbert Hoover Middle School boiler and the multipurpose rooms for Lincoln, Woodbrook and Martin Luther King Elementary Schools. The awards for these bids will be presented to the Board for approval in June.
- Mr. Messineo summarized the summer capital projects for thirteen of the district school buildings. Major emphasis was given to renovations of the Home Economics rooms in Herbert Hoover, John Adams and Thomas Jefferson Middle Schools and Edison High School.
- Mr. Rienzi gave an update on the construction of the Edison High School Science addition: There were change orders for \$2,036 for heater cabinets and \$856 for black-out film on the canopy glass. The John P. Stevens High School turf field construction is on schedule and the 3 foot pipes for drainage are on site and ready for installation.
- The new budget snapshot was presented showing a final tax increase of \$64: \$24 from spending increases and \$40 due to the ratable decreases of \$58,490,839. The tax rate increase for the previous three years has been 1.7%, 0% and .4%.
- With the addition of the \$2.1 million allocated in the 2013-14 budget, the total capital reserve account totals \$5,487,711.
- The salary increases for exempt employees were reviewed and recommendations for action by the Board will be presented in June.
