

I. CALL TO ORDER/FLAG SALUTE

The September 21, 2015 Public Meeting of the Edison Board of Education was called to order by Board President, Mrs. Veena Iyer, at 7:00 P.M. at Herbert Hoover Middle School, 174 Jackson Avenue, Edison, NJ.

Herbert Hoover Middle School Student, Madison Fuentes, led the Pledge of Allegiance.

III. OPENING STATEMENT

Mrs. Iyer read the following opening statement:

"The New Jersey Open Public Meetings Law was enacted to insure the right of the public to have advance notice of and to attend the meetings of public bodies at which any business affecting their interests is discussed or acted upon.

In accordance with the provisions of this act, the Edison Board of Education has caused notice of this meeting to be published by having the date, time and place thereof posted in the Board of Education Administrative Offices. Copies of these notices were sent to the Home News and Tribune and the Star Ledger on March 31, 2014.

The Public may participate at regular meetings in accordance with the By-Laws and the applicable State regulations.

IV. RECOGNITION – HERBERT HOOVER MIDDLE SCHOOL

Mr. Brian McGrath, Principal, spoke how the amazing people of Herbert Hoover Middle School are working to provide students with an education that will serve them for the rest of their lives, since it has become increasingly difficult to predict what children will need as they transition into high school, college, career, and that unpredictable thing we call adult life.

It has become increasingly difficult in response to the ever changing world, Herbert Hoover Middle school has become a model for 21st Century Learning. The start of this school year ushered in a new era for Hoover and our sister middle schools. Within the first week, every middle school student in our district received their very own Chromebook.

Mr. McGrath pointed out the significance of this movement. For as long as schools have existed, children have attended with the core experience based in a transfer of knowledge from the teacher to the student. A few weeks ago, each student was provided with a device that will allow them to access unfathomable amounts of information, radically altering every aspect of the school experience. Within the past months our teachers have digitized their resources and materials. They have researched and implemented countless apps and created Google Classrooms that incorporate all the traditional elements of school with the added efficiencies of the digital world. In all classrooms you will find students who are researching, collaborating, and creating in ways that could not have been imagined just a few years ago. In short, we are in the midst of what may be the most significant transformation our schools have seen in many decades.

Here at Hoover, we recognize this transformation must be rooted in a rigorous curriculum, we believe children should still be exposed to robust music and art programs, children deserve a clean and safe facility, and all children should be supported and challenged by a faculty and staff that is caring, highly educated, and always looking towards the future. Herbert Hoover Middle School is attuned to the needs of our students, parents, and the community. Mr. McGrath said he is proud to say that we are providing students with the education they need to be successful here and beyond.

Mr. McGrath also honored School Nurse/District Head Nurse, Carol Martinez, for her role in saving the life of a student during the 7th grade class trip last June. Mrs. Martinez provided CPR on the student until the ambulance arrived after the student’s heart stopped.
