

I. CALL TO ORDER/FLAG SALUTE

The December 21, 2015 Public Meeting of the Edison Board of Education was called to order by Board President, Mrs. Veena Iyer, at 7:00 P.M. at Martin Luther King Elementary School, 285 Tingley Lane, Edison, NJ.

Martin Luther King Elementary School Student Council members Annika Santhanam (President), Dev Parikh (Vice President) and Rhea Sansguiri (Secretary) led the Pledge of Allegiance.

II. ROLL CALL

III. OPENING STATEMENT

Mrs. Iyer read the following opening statement:

"The New Jersey Open Public Meetings Law was enacted to insure the right of the public to have advance notice of and to attend the meetings of public bodies at which any business affecting their interests is discussed or acted upon.

In accordance with the provisions of this act, the Edison Board of Education has caused notice of this meeting to be published by having the date, time and place thereof posted in the Board of Education Administrative Offices. Copies of these notices were sent to the Home News and Tribune and the Star Ledger on March 31, 2014.

The Public may participate at regular meetings in accordance with the By-Laws and the applicable State regulations.

IV. RECOGNITION

- Mrs. Iyer presented the "I Am Edison Public School" video, recognizing "Hidden Heroes" – the Board of Education IT Department. Dr. O'Malley commended the IT Department for their dedication to the students of the Edison Public Schools.
- Mrs. Diane Wilton, Principal of Martin Luther King Elementary School, presented the Board with "Celebrations and love of learning at MLK School." She thanked Dr. O'Malley, Mrs. Iyer, and members of the Board of Education for selecting the MLK learning community to host this evening's Board of Education meeting and for encouraging her students to share the celebrations and love of learning at MLK, particularly as this time of year which brings so many celebrations. Mrs. Wilton also thanked Brandon Uhlig and Don Platvoet who spent a full day at MLK School to document how the teachers and students learn side by side in a rich learning environment that is balanced and affords the students extended learning opportunities.

She stated that she always tell the parents and the community that “MLK School is where our students first begin their journey in their formal education process. Our goal, though, is to instill the love of learning through celebrations of achievement we see each day at our school.”

In recognition of how her students’ love of learning and how it extends beyond the classroom doors at MLK, Mrs. Wilton introduced Aadhitya Raam Ashok, who is a fifth grader at MLK. Aadhitya loves learning in the realm of music. Through his deep interest and talent in music composition, Aadhitya entered and earned first place in the New Jersey State Music Teachers National Association competition last year for his composition “The Seasons Change.” This afforded Aadhitya opportunities to perform his composition at the Golden Key Music Festival at Ehrbar Hall and at Bosendorfer Hall at Mozarthaus where he took master classes, in Vienna, Austria this past summer. He took first place again at the MTNA composition category for New Jersey and is currently advancing to the Eastern Division finals. Aadhitya Raam Ashok played a short section of his composition, “The Seasons Change.”

Aadhitya was given a student certificate for his accomplishments.

Mrs. Wilton, with the assistance of Brandon Uhlig and Don Platvoet, presented a video on the celebrations of learning on a typical day at MLK School affording all the opportunity to understand their philosophy of developing the whole child as they are engaged in rich learning opportunities, so these young learners may apply their newly discovered learning both inside school and in their learning experiences outside the classroom. She said she does believe this video can state our celebrations and love of learning better than any words she can use to describe how proud she is of all the learners, young and adult at MLK.
