


The Associate of Applied Science Degree in Multimedia Web Design program is a collaborative effort from Sachse High School and Richland College. What classes would I take?

Students in the program take classes such as Digital Media, Web Design, Animation and Digital Imaging in addition to the required core content. The focus of the program is on developing marketable skills in the creation, manipulation and publication of digital work.

The program utilizes industry standard software such as Adobe Photoshop, Adobe Illustrator, Adobe InDesign and more.

What will I learn?

You will learn to create and edit digital images, video, audio and animation. You'll know how to create and publish content for the Internet including web sites and blogs. Through the program you will gain knowledge in the theory and practice of digital design as well as digital marketing. You can also use the skills developed to earn industry certifications from Adobe that will make you more marketable to employers.

What can an AAS in Multimedia Web Design do for me?

- Better prepare you to enter the workforce when you graduate from high school.
- Help you earn a starting salary that ranges from 35,000 -60,000 a year.
- Provide you with the means to develop a professional portfolio.
- You will graduate with an Associate of Applied Science degree when you graduate from high school.
