Dear Students, Families & Staff of Parkway School,

Earlier this school year results from routine water testing showed elevated signs of Coliform and e Coli Bacteria. The tests were taken during the period when the system was off line to allow for the replacement of the faucets in all of the classroom areas. Once the work on the faucets was completed the entire system was flushed out by the crew from Foley Pump Service, our Public Water System Operator, and additional tests were completed on the water. The second round of tests completed on August 28 2019 showed no signs of the bacteria however, the Connecticut Department of Public Health had mandated that the testing be completed within the time frame of August 19 – August 25. As a result of our testing lab missing the deadline by 3 days a Notice of Violation (attached) was issued.

This letter, along with the Public Notification and Certificate of Compliance, will close out the CTDOHP violation.


