Dear Students, Families & Staff of Parkway School:

Earlier this year a request was made to the State of Connecticut Department of Public Health (DPH) drinking Water Section for approval to alter the delivery method of the Consumer Notice of Lead Tap Water Results. An approval was granted and you now have access to view test results of lead sampling and notifications regarding the water supply via the school's website at:

Unfortunately, our office failed to meet the time frame established by DPH (30 days) to set up the new delivery method (website page) and a violation was issued. The DPH, as well as the Greenwich Public Schools Facilities Department, take these matters very seriously and will continue with our responsibilities to ensure the quality of the drinking water at Parkway School. We are certain all pertinent information has now been provided to DPH and should be in compliance.

Please note, the testing of the water and results were available via the community board in the school lobby during this time period. All test results were within acceptable ranges and at no time was the quality of the drinking water in question.

Along with the assistance of Foley's Pump Service, we will continue to monitor the well water and keep you informed of all issues and concerns. Please contact the Greenwich Public Schools Facilities Department at (203) 625-7450 should you have any questions.
