- Collect qualitative and quantitative data to inform ٠ Family E3 strategies
- Provide Family E3 educational programming ٠

Engage

- Use research and priority District Improvement Plan goals to develop and implement Family E3 evidence-based strategies and programs
- Provide intentional feedback and engagement opportunities, and ٠ appropriately respond to address the needs of all families including, but not limited to, families of students with disabilities, English Language Learners, Homeless, Economically Disadvantaged, and all minority students and under-represented groups
- Work cross-functionally to assure alignment of Family E3 initiatives. ٠ (e.g., External Funding, Academics, Family E3)
- Work collaboratively to support campus leaders and Family E3 teams
- Lead Family E3 partner investigation and development to yield a marketplace of Family E3-aligned partners and programming

- Set expectations for authentic relationship building on your campus
- Ensure outstanding customer service, a welcoming environment and a designated space for all families guided by the SBISD Share A Smile Customer Service Commitments

(Embrace Diversity)

- Ensure campus culture is inclusive of all cultures within the ٠ school community
- Implement the Spring Branch ISD Translation Policy (as required by ESSA)

Empower

- (Support Advocacy) Implement timely, strategic, two-way communication with all families
- Empower and equip families to advocate for their students' success ٠ and equip staff to be responsive

- Provide authentic engagement opportunities that honor all • families' contributions
- Develop and implement, together with families, strategically aligned Parent Compacts and Family Engagement Plans (Title I schools - required non-Title I schools - recommended)

- Ensure your child's campus has your current contact information

Empower

- Be an advocate for your child
- Provide meaningful feedback through surveys, evaluations, and focus groups
