Craft Fair Recap: Took in \$2,311 expenses was \$-150. Net profit of \$2,161. Estimated 450+ shoppers. Total of 57 vendors. Only 1 didn't show up. (And they had already paid for their booth) Sara did to a survey to the vendors. Feedback: only 1 said it was unsuccessful; everyone else said highly successful. Largest complaint was the food choice. 9/22 vendors surveyed said their complaint is not enough food choices. \$583 from silent auction. (\$30 was spent on "extras"- the rest of the items were donated)

SB – (for next year) knowing who's going to help is going to help the craft fair be less stressful. We already have banners. Looking at Nov 14th for next year. SB, we submitted the paperwork to district for the use of Watson.
