

5880 PUBLIC PERFORMANCES BY PUPILS

Pupils, staff members or school facilities shall not be used in any manner for advertising or promoting the interests of any non-school agency or private organization without the approval of the Superintendent. Staff members may not release the names, addresses or telephone numbers of pupils to any outside individual or agency, except as approved by the Superintendent.

Public school pupils on, in or about the premises of the district are not permitted to participate in any campaign to raise funds for any purpose, nor may teachers permit such drives, within the classroom unless approved by the Superintendent.

School organizations and pupils may participate in community activities upon approval of the Superintendent. Teachers are encouraged to interest their pupils in public performances when such performances contribute to the educational process and objectives of the Board and when they do not interfere with other scheduled activities or the regular process of education.

In addition, special activity requests must comply with the following:

- A. When the activity is outside of the school facilities, parental permission must be received;
- B. In no instance shall the organization, class or pupil, be paid for participation; and
- C. All requests must be approved by the Principal or designee.
