Dear Parent/Guardian:

Seniors who have been legitimately scheduled for Study Hall during the last few periods of the day may be released from school early at the conclusion of their last regularly scheduled class, provided they have parental consent and comply with the following:

- 1. Specific arrangements assuring the school that the student will be safely transported home immediately following the student's last scheduled class.
- 2. Assurance that the student will abide by the specific guidelines governing students on early release programs.

Students must attend all other classes on a regular basis. One class cut could constitute immediate loss of this privilege.

Students must leave school premises immediately following their last scheduled class. Loitering on or near the school property will result in the immediate loss of early release. Early release students must provide their own afternoon transportation; **they may not ride the bus home.**

Students may not remain on the property for any reason without permission from Administration.

Please keep in mind, the building principal reserves the right to suspend this privilege when there is evidence of non-compliance by students with the above mentioned guidelines and conditions.

If you consent to this early dismissal, complete the permission form below and have your son/daughter return it to the attendance office by **Friday**, **September 20**. If we do not receive the permission form by this date, your child may be assigned to study halls in lieu of early release. If there are any questions concerning this program, please feel free to call my office.

When you return the form you must bring your Student ID to receive an Early Release sticker.
