Congratulations to GSHS students in Ms. Marcum's Gulf Coast Ecology and Marine Biology Classes for winning the most oysters in multiple spat bags for the Little Lagoon oyster gardening program this year! They grew a total of 4,082 oysters with an average height of 2.2 inches. These oysters provide water filtration benefits, increased habitat and will help restore almost 5.1 acres of decimated reefs in Mobile Bay.
