White Bear Lake's North Oaks Full-day Preschool

Age 4 by Sept 1, 2020

This full day, year-before-kindergarten program is designed to help children prepare to enter kindergarten with the skills and behaviors necessary to be successful. Children who are four years old before September 1 of the current school year and are toilet trained are eligible to enroll.

Children work on listening, personal and social development, language and literacy, thinking and math skills through guided play, group time, and social interaction. Activities include language arts, math, science, art, large muscle (gym/outside), dramatic play, blocks, and music.

*Children must bring their own lunches

◆ For Currently Enrolled WBLA Preschool and ECCE Students

Students participating in 2019-2020 classes as of December 15, 2019, priority preschool registration is open from Monday, January 6 until Thursday, January 16. Families will be notified if they do not receive their first class option.

◆ New Students not currently attending WBLA Preschool or ECCE classes may register beginning Tuesday, January 21.

◆ Registrations will be accepted online and in-person at Normandy Park Education Center.

Registrations MUST include the following items or your enrollment will not be accepted

- ◆ A non-refundable \$55 registration fee
- ◆ Copy of birth certificate (new families only)
- ◆ Current immunization record ***required every year**

Class Fees

All class costs are for the entire school year (Sept - May). Parents will be invoiced a monthly fee based on program costs. Payments are due the first day of each month. Nature Preschool fees are higher to cover the costs of a Ramsey County Naturalist.

School Readiness

Your child may qualify for tuition assistance based on the following eligibility requirements which include:

- ◆ Income
- ◆ Homeless/Foster Care
- ◆ Home first language
- ◆ Health and development

School Readiness Plus - 4 year old Preschool

Age 4 by Sept 1, 2020

This is a year before kindergarten preschool option for students who live within the Birch Lake, Willow Lane or Vadnais Heights Elementary school boundaries. In order to enroll in this preschool at a reduced rate, a student must meet one of the following eligibility requirements:

- ◆ Homeless
- ◆ Foster Care
- ◆ English Language Learner
- ◆ At-risk Early Childhood Screening score
- ◆ Income

If your student does not meet any of these criteria, your child(ren) is still eligible to attend for a fee. The cost will be based on our School Readiness Plus sliding fee scale.

Preschool sections are either morning (9 - 11:45 am) or afternoon (1 - 3:40 pm). Limited transportation available. Please find more information regarding qualifications and/or costs on our web page at

Tuition Assistance

Pathway I Early Learning Scholarships

To be eligible for a scholarship, families must

- ◆ live in Anoka, Dakota, Hennepin, Ramsey, Scott, or Washington counties
- ◆ have a child(ren) who is 3 or 4 years old by September 1 of the current school year and not yet eligible for kindergarten
- ◆ have an annual income at or below 185% of the Federal Poverty
- ◆ have an Early Childhood Screening completed

Full-day 4 year old program

Bear FUNDamentals is a year-before-kindergarten program focused on providing fun, nurturing and enriching opportunities for learning and play that prepare children for kindergarten. Located at Birch, Hugo, Lakeaires, and Otter Schools, the program runs from 9 am-3:45 pm with the option of registering for Extended Day hours before or after school.

Bear FUNDamentals focuses on children's emotional, social, physical and intellectual growth. Children work on listening skills, language and literacy, thinking and math skills, and social development through meaningful, interactive play. The program is staffed at a 1:10 ratio and taught by passionate instructors who encourage curiosity, discovery, and problem-solving in a stimulating, structured, and engaging environment.

Families can register for school day or full day (6:30am-6:00pm) hours, three to five days per week. Students registered for a White Bear preschool course will receive a discounted price.

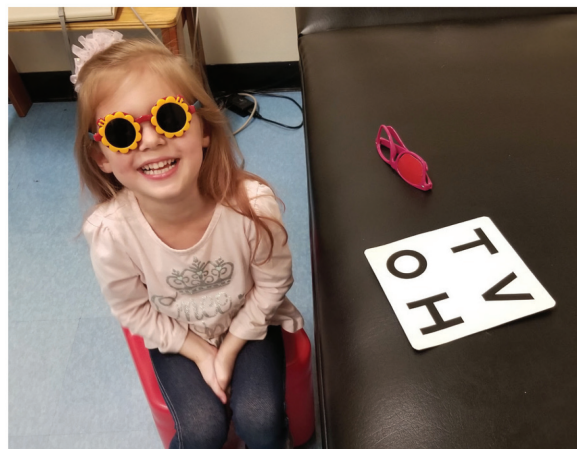
