



# Ready, Set, READ!

***Ready, Set, Read!*** is a reading program open to students entering grades 1-5

Skilled teachers will provide reading, spelling and writing instruction in an intervention program utilizing phonological awareness and sequential, multisensory, Orton-Gillingham based approaches to teach students who struggle with the reading process or have been diagnosed with dyslexia. Each class will consist of no more than three students in a group.

Students can:

- Gain improvements in phonological awareness, phonics, decoding and reading fluency skills
- Learn strategies for improved reading comprehension
- Increase spelling and writing skills
- Become more self-confident and independent learners
