Behavioral and Academic Expectations Required to be met in order to participate:

8th Grade Class Field Trip to Dorney Park* (*based on date availability)

- No suspensions Beginning December 17, 2020
- No more than 10 detentions Beginning December 17, 2020
- No more than 1 F for the year
- No more than 21 lateness's

8th Grade Move Up Ceremony

- Must not be failing the 8th grade (in danger of being retained)

Class Dues

- All families are asked to contribute \$100.00 for 8th grade dues.
- This money will be used to purchase a yearbook, a t-shirt, 8th Grade Social, certificates, and a field trip ticket for your warrior.
- Please hand in all money to Mr. Brody and please, **cash only**.
- **NOTE:** This money is non-refundable. If your student does not meet field trip expectations, they will not be allowed to attend and the money will not be refunded to you.
- **The first installment of \$50.00 will be due January 6th (after winter break)**
- **The second installment of \$50.00 will be due April 3rd (before spring break)**
