Levels

Tots (ages 5 and 6)

Never skated before or has minimum experience. Can march across the ice and get up. Two-footed glide forward swizzle. Can skate across the ice. Swizzles, gliding, snow plow stop.

Beginner through Delta (ages 7-14)

Pre-Alpha: Cannot skate or never skated before. One-and-two-foot glides, forward swizzle and backward wiggle.

Alpha A: Forward crossovers (both directions) and one-foot snow plow stop.

Beta: Backward crossovers (both directions) and backward stroking, spirals and T-stops.

Gamma: Forward outside 3-turns, forward inside mohawk and hockey stop.

Delta: Forward inside 3-turns, forward outside and inside edges, Bunny Hop and Shoot the Duck.

Adults:

Adult 1: Never skated before.

Adult 2: Moving two-foot turns, crossovers, forward edge rolls and backward one-foot glide.

Adult 3: Forward and backward crossovers (both directions) and one-foot snow plow stop.

NEW: POWER SKATING AND STROKING CLASS (all ages)

Must know forward and backward crossovers to participate.

Ice Skating lesson liability waiver 2019- 2020 Season

THE SCHEDULED PREPAID LESSONS NOT TAKEN BY THE END OF THE 2019-2020 ICE SKATING SEASON ARE NOT REFUNDABLE AND WILL EXPIRE.

Participant acknowledges that Ice skating involves certain risks, dangers and hazards that may result in serious personal injury. The use of ice skating equipment may also result in serious personal injury. The skater and the skater’s parent or legal guardian (if the skater is under 18) accept and assume all risk of injury while using the Roosevelt Park Family Ice Skating Rink. This includes, but is not limited to, injury to the skater and any other person. All skaters must follow the Rules and Regulations of the Roosevelt Park Family Ice Skating Rink and Rules and Regulations of the Middlesex County Office of Parks and Recreation as adopted by the Board of Chosen Freeholders.

ALL SKATERS SKATE AT THEIR OWN RISK

At all times, the skater and skater’s parent or legal guardian (if the skater is under 18) are fully responsible for personal injury and property damage caused by the skater and the skater’s parent or legal guardian shall defend and hold harmless the Middlesex County Office of Parks and Recreation, the County of Middlesex and their respective members, officials, officers, agents and employers for any and all claims, demands, and causes of action asserted against any of them arising from the skater’s use of the Roosevelt Park Family Ice Skating Rink and entry upon the premises. Skater understands that lessons may be provided by independent parties.

Participant and/or their parent(s) or guardian permits the Roosevelt Park Family Ice Skating Rink to use any photographs, videotapes, recordings or any other records taken while on the Ice skating rink premises for our website, publicity, advertising, or any other legitimate purpose.
