- Confers with parent, when necessary, together with the teachers/administrators and other professional personnel with regard to student problems
- Participates in child study team conferences, i.e., interdisciplinary sharing of data, as well as conferences with parents and school personnel
- Assists in the preparation of an Individual Education Program for classified students
- Screens students for special projects and programs, such as academically talented, kindergarten alert and retention
