- Conducts informational and/or counseling sessions with parents and/or students
- Intervenes in crisis situations directly with students and consults with school personnel
- Participates in child study team conferences, i.e., interdisciplinary sharing of data, as well as conferences with parents and school personnel

- Performs such other duties as may be assigned by the Superintendent or designee
