Led by Jayne L. Reed, a small group of Tulsans met with opera star Simon Estes who was in town to perform with the Tulsa Opera. Bound by a mutual belief in the importance of education and concern for the many bright high school seniors financially unable to attend college, the group decided to do what they could to assist these promising young students. As a result, in 1983 The Simon Estes Educational Foundation, Inc. was created with Mr. Estes and Ms. Reed as Cofounders.

In the last thirty-two years, the Foundation has raised over three million dollars in actual grants and future commitments for scholarships. The Foundation has assisted 422 scholars to attend prestigious colleges and universities throughout this country and have participated in international study programs abroad. All graduates have taken their places in the professional world and serve as the greatest endorsement of the Foundation.

Our Mission continues to be a multiracial, nonprofit Oklahoma organization, committed to promoting higher educational opportunities for Tulsa area high school seniors by providing scholarships made possible through charitable contributions. Moreover, The Simon Estes Educational Foundation not only provides funding, but it seeks to foster relationships with its students by providing mentoring opportunities throughout their college experience. While special consideration is given to African American, Asian/Pacific Islander, Hispanic, and Native American students, all applicants exhibiting scholastic excellence, financial need, and high moral standards are considered regardless of race, religion, sex, or ethnic origin. ### **☐ THE SCHOLARSHIP**

The Simon Estes Educational Foundation Scholarship offers a \$2,500 scholarship to graduating high school seniors planning to attend college this coming fall term. This award may be renewed annually up to four years based on available funding - renewal amounts may vary. The funds can be applied to tuition, books, fees or university room and board. The applicant must be a U.S. citizen or a foreign national with resident status. Students who are in the U.S. on a Student Visa are not eligible for the scholarship. Scholarship funding can be applied to any public or private 4-year university or college.

To maintain the scholarship, students must retain a 3.0 grade point average, be enrolled full-time and provide an official transcript each semester. Additionally, students must write their designated Simon Estes sponsor twice a year, attend Foundation functions as requested and complete 4 hours of volunteer service arranged by the Foundation. Awards are limited and ALL deadlines are **strongly** enforced.

**SELECTION:** All applications are reviewed by a Pre-Screening Committee with top candidates being contacted for a personal interview with the Selection Committee. Those students selected as Simon Estes Scholars will be notified by mail.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Applicants are carefully reviewed on the basis of a combination of criteria:

- Documented financial need
- High School G.P.A. of 3.5 or higher (weighted/un-weighted)
- ACT or SAT scores
- Prior acceptance to the college or university of choice
- Permanent residence within a thirty-mile radius of Tulsa
- A well-defined motivation to pursue higher education and a personal sense of values

- 1. Do not leave questions blank. Use N/A (not applicable) in the blank if question does not apply to you.
- 2. Typed answers are preferred.
- 3. Do not staple any items.
- 4. Provide full addresses with zip codes.
- 5. Submit an official transcript bearing the first semester grades of the senior year with ACT or SAT scores.
- 6. Attach a <u>SIGNED</u> copy of parent/guardian 2020 tax return(s) (Usually IRS form 1040 or 1040A). <u>Please note that parents who complete their own tax returns must submit copies of all 2020 W2 Forms. All related tax schedules must be submitted with tax returns.</u>
- 7. If taxes are professionally prepared, copies bearing preparer's signature and the company name should be submitted.
- 8. Legally emancipated minors must submit their own 2020 tax return and follow the stated guidelines. Proof of emancipation must be included.
- 9. Applications and all supporting documentation must be received no later than 5:00 p.m., March 20, 2020.
