



Assessment Data Highlights

• AP Data

- CollegeBoard AP
- 92.4% AP Passage Rate- Up from 88% in 2016
- 30% of Students grade 10-12 took and passed AP test
- Number of AP exams taken increased from 486 in 2016 to 532 in 2017
- ACT
 - LBHS Composite Score 25.8 State Average is 22.8
 - 94% of our students ready for College Level Coursework in ELA
 - 77% ready for College Algebra and College Social Science
 - 70% in Biology compared to 46% State Average
- UC/CSU Eligibility
 - 76% of graduating Seniors UC Eligible Up from 66% in 2015-16
