Certification that Laguna Beach Unified School District has Levied Home-To-School Transportation Fees in Accordance with Law for the 2016-2017 Fiscal Year

Proposal

Staff proposes the Board of Education certify that Laguna Beach Unified School District has levied fees in accordance with law.

Background

In accordance with Education Code Section 39809.5, it is reported that the bus fees currently collected by the Laguna Beach Unified School District are not adequate in and of themselves to eliminate the encroachment of pupil transportation on the general fund.

State aid revenue and the transportation fees collected in a fiscal year do not exceed the actual operating costs of pupil transportation in the same fiscal year.

Budget Impact

Although the State LCFF calculates a \$379,430 add-on for pupil transportation, since the District is basic aid, no state aid is received for bus transportation.

In 2015-16, home-to-school transportation expenditures were \$1,070,518. Special Education transportation expenditures were \$613,981. Bus pass fees collections amount to \$308,745. The 2015-16 encroachment for home-to-school transportation is \$761,773. The 2015-2016 encroachment for Special Education is \$613,981.

Recommended Action

Staff recommends the Board of Education certify that Laguna Beach Unified School District has levied home-to-school transportation fees in accordance with law.

Rather than relocate the existing lines, staff recommends adjusting the position of the new shade structures, which will result in much lower costs for the project. The not-to-exceed amount of \$30,000 for general legal counsel for the 2016-2017 school year.

Recommended Action

Staff recommends the Board of Education approve the agreement with Fagen Friedman & Fulfrost for general legal counsel for the 2016-2017 school year, with a not-to-exceed amount of \$30,000.



AGREEMENT FOR LEGAL SERVICES

This agreement is by and between Laguna Beach School District ("Client") and the law firm of Fagen Friedman & Fulfrost LLP ("Attorney"). In consideration of the promises and the mutual agreements hereinafter contained, Attorney agrees to provide legal services to Client on the terms set forth below effective July 1, 2016:

- 1. <u>CONDITIONS</u>. This Agreement will not take effect, and Attorney will have no obligation to provide legal services, until Client returns a signed copy of this Agreement.
- 2. SCOPE OF SERVICES. Client hires Attorney as its legal representative/counsel with respect to matters Client specifically refers to Attorney. Attorney will provide those legal services reasonably required to represent Client. Attorney will take reasonable steps to keep Client informed of progress and to respond to Client's inquiries.
- 3. <u>CLIENT'S DUTIES</u>. Client agrees to cooperate with Attorney and to communicate with candor while keeping the Attorney apprised of any information or developments which may come to Client's attention, to abide by this Agreement, to pay Attorney's bills on time and to keep Attorney advised of Client's address and telephone number. Client will assist Attorney in providing information and documents necessary for the representation in the described matter.
- 4. <u>CONSULTANT SERVICES</u>. Attorney may provide consulting services in addition to or in support of the legal services provided pursuant to this Agreement, through qualified non-attorney Communication Services and Education Consultants. These services are intended to support Client with communications work or educational consultant services related to labor and employment matters, special education and student matters, high-profile litigation and settlement agreements, in addition to employee, community, inter-governmental and media relations.
- 5. EMAIL COMMUNICATIONS/CLOUD-BASED COMPUTING. In order to provide Client with efficient and convenient legal services, Attorney will frequently communicate and transmit documents using e-mail. In addition, Attorney uses a cloud computing service with servers located in a facility other than Attorney's office. Most of Attorney's electronic data, including emails and documents, are stored in this manner. Although Attorney will take reasonable precautions to keep email and other electronic data confidential and secure, because technology and cyber threats continue to evolve, there may be risks communicating and storing electronic data in this manner, including risks related to confidentiality and security. By entering into this Agreement, Client is consenting to such e-mail transmissions with Client and Client's representatives and agents, as well as to having communications, documents and electronic data pertinent to Client's matter(s) stored through a cloud-based service.

6. <u>LEGAL FEES AND BILLING PRACTICES</u>. Client agrees to pay by the hour, in minimum units of one tenth (.1) of an hour, at Attorney's prevailing rates for all time spent on Client's matter by Attorney's legal personnel. Current hourly rates are noted in an attached rate schedule and the actual rate billed is based on the attorney's number of years of experience.

The rates on this schedule are subject to change on 30 days' written notice to client. If Client declines to pay any increased rates, Attorney will have the right to withdraw as Attorney for Client. The time charged will include the time Attorney spends on telephone calls relating to Client's matter, including calls with Client and other parties and attorneys. The legal personnel assigned to Client's matter may confer among themselves about the matter, as required and appropriate. When they do confer, each person will charge for the time expended, as long as the work done is reasonably necessary and not duplicative. Likewise, if more than one of the legal personnel attends a meeting or other proceeding, each will charge for the time spent.

7. COSTS AND OTHER CHARGES. (a) In general, Attorney will incur various costs and expenses in performing legal services under this Agreement. Client agrees to pay for all costs, disbursements and expenses in addition to the hourly fees. The statements shall include the amount, rate, basis of calculation or other method of determination of the fees and costs, which costs will be clearly identified by item and amount.
- 9. <u>DISCHARGE AND WITHDRAWAL</u>. Client may discharge Attorney at any time. Attorney may withdraw with Client's consent, for good cause or as allowed or required by law upon ten (10) days written notice. Good cause includes Client's breach of this Agreement, refusal to cooperate or to follow Attorney's advice on a material matter or any fact or circumstance that would render Attorney's continuing representation unlawful or unethical. When Attorney's services conclude, all unpaid charges will immediately become due and payable. After services

conclude, Attorney will, upon Client's request, deliver Client's file(s) and property in Attorney's possession, whether or not Client has paid for all services. Attorney shall transition all outstanding legal work and services to others as Client shall direct.

- 10. <u>DISCLAIMER OF GUARANTEE AND ESTIMATES</u>. Nothing in this Agreement and nothing in Attorney's statements to Client will be construed as a promise or guarantee about the outcome of the matter. Attorney makes no such promises or guarantees. Attorney's comments about the outcome of the matter are expressions of opinion only. Actual fees may vary from estimates given.
- 11. <u>ENTIRE AGREEMENT</u>. This Agreement contains the entire agreement of the parties. No other agreement, statement, or promise made on or before the effective date of this Agreement will be binding on the parties.
- 12. MODIFICATION BY SUBSEQUENT AGREEMENT. This Agreement may be modified by subsequent agreement of the parties only by an instrument in writing signed by both of them or an oral agreement only to the extent that the parties carry it out.
- 13. <u>SEVERABILITY IN EVENT OF PARTIAL INVALIDITY.</u> If any provision of this Agreement is held in whole or in part to be unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of that provision and of the entire Agreement will be severable and remain in effect.

Proposal

Staff proposes the Board of Education approve Resolution #16-12: Increase 2015-2016 Gann Limit by \$2,194,323.00 and Adoption of the 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 District Appropriations Subject to GANN Limits.

Background

Each year the Board approves the GANN Limit calculation. The numbers that go into the calculation are based on specific formulas set by the State according to applicable constitutional and statutory law and supplied to the District by the California Department of Education.

For the 2015-2016 GANN Limit Calculation, there is an increase in the appropriations limit of \$2,194,323.00. The increase of the appropriations limit will permanently increase our appropriations limit and should have virtually no adverse effect due to our increase being absorbed in the State's own total GANN limit. Government code 7902.1(a) states:

If, beginning with the 1980-81 fiscal year or any fiscal year thereafter, the proceeds of taxes of a school district, community college district, or county superintendent of schools, exceed its appropriations limit determined pursuant to Section 7902 for that fiscal year, the governing body of the school district, community college district, or the county superintendent of schools, may increase its appropriations limit to an amount equal to its proceeds of taxes.

Approval by the Board of Education of Resolution #16-12 – Increase of \$2,194,323.00 Appropriations Limit to the 2015-2016 GANN Limit will satisfy the requirement of Government Code Section 7902.1(a).

Budget Impact

No budget impact will result from approval of this Resolution.
