A career continuing education program in Technical Theatre offers instruction in the design and construction of scenery, special effects and lighting. Other areas explored include sound, props, stage management and costumes. The Technical Theatre pathway is for students who may have a desire to pursue a career in the entertainment technology field that includes theater, film, video, communications, and careers that rely heavily on project management, creative solutions and diverse groups of workers. Technical Theatre is two periods and earns three credits each year. You can work toward an associate degree with the help of a \$3,000 Sinclair Tech Prep Scholarship and earn college credit in high school toward your degree. Students can take any Advanced Placement or Honors classes while taking this program!
