Driving Directions (We do not recommend renting a car; the directions are just for reference)

From O'Hare Airport (17.8 Miles):

- Take I-90 (Kennedy Expressway) or I-94 (Eden's Expressway) southeast into the downtown Chicago area.]
- Take the OHIO ST. EAST exit (600 North – Exit number 50B)
- Head EAST on OHIO ST.
- Turn RIGHT at N STATE ST.
- End at 505 N STATE ST CHICAGO IL

From Midway Airport (13.5 Miles):

- Take I-55 North (Stevenson Expressway) to northbound LAKE SHORE DRIVE.
- Take the I-90 W/RYAN EXPY/I-94 W exit- exit number 292A- toward WISCONSIN.
- Merge onto I-90 W/I-94 W via exit number 53A toward WISCONSIN/CANALPORT AVE/CERMAK RD.
- Take the EAST OHIO ST exit- exit number 50B.
- Head EAST on OHIO ST.
- Turn RIGHT onto N STATE ST.
- End at 505 N STATE ST CHICAGO

Public Transportation

The Hotel Palomar is very convenient to public transportation and particularly the “L” train. The hotel is less than one block south of the Red Line train’s Grand Avenue stop. Exit the Red Line at Grand, walk south on State Street. The hotel is on the east side of State Street. Cost \$3.00. If you intend to ride the CTA frequently, you may wish to purchase a 1-Day pass for \$10.00. If you visit Chicago often, you may wish to purchase a reloadable Ventra card for \$5.00 and the cost of the card can be applied to transit fees and a single ride will be \$2.50. “L” Train from O’Hare Airport: (45 minutes to 1 hour)

Follow the signs for the Trains to the City. Take the CTA Blue Line to Jackson. Follow signs to transfer to the Red Line, toward Howard. Exit at Grand Avenue and follow above directions to reach the hotel. Cost of a single-ride ticket \$5.00 from O’Hare to downtown and \$3.00 from downtown to O’Hare.

“L” Train from Midway Airport: (45 minutes)

Follow the signs for the Trains to the City. Take the CTA Orange Line to the State and Lake stop. Transfer to the Red Line toward Howard. Exit at Grand, and follow above directions to reach the hotel. Cost \$3.00.

GO Airport Express (Share-a-Ride) Shuttle Service

ISACS has negotiated a special rate with GO Airport Express for ISACS members – 15% off standard rates. Reservations **MUST** be made in advance and online to receive the discounted rate. The standard rate per person to/from O’Hare is approximately \$28 one-way; \$49 round-trip. The standard rate per person to/from Midway is approximately \$24 one-way; \$40 round-trip. A credit card is required and charged at the time of reservation. Airport walk-ups are not eligible for the discounted rate, standard rates apply. Parties of two or more reserving at the same time receive a discount.

Hotel Palomar Valet Parking – Updated Rates for 2020!

The Hotel Palomar offers valet parking service. Valet event parking for daily parking (not overnight) is \$26/day. Please visit the hotel’s main desk prior to your departure to pay by cash or credit card for your daily parking.

Overnight valet parking is \$64/night for hotel guests with in and out privileges and will be billed directly to your guest folio. Typically, additional charges to overnight parking get added at 2:00 pm. However, overnight guests for the Academy for Division Heads can park their cars with the valet until 4:00 pm on Friday without additional fees.

Hybrid vehicles receive a 25% discount. Prices are subject to change.

There are parking lots close to the hotel that may be less expensive.

Prepaid Discounted Parking Option

You may be able to find reduced parking rates by using ParkWhiz for daily and/or overnight parking in downtown Chicago. Visit www.parkwhiz.com or download their app. The website/app allows you to enter your destination address, compare price/location, make a reservation and receive an electronic parking pass to print or use on your smartphone.
