



## Transfer Student Applicant Instructions

You may apply by downloading and submitting the online application packet. To ensure your application for transfer is complete and processed in a timely manner, please submit the following information:

- Transfer Application
- Personal Statement
- Resume of co-curricular activities
- High School academic grades
- Standardized test scores
- Personal letter of recommendation

St. Xavier High School welcomes students from all faiths, backgrounds and walks of life. The primary consideration for transfer admission to St. Xavier High School is the prospective student's academic ability as measured by standardized scores and the candidate's current high school academic record.

Other admission criteria include:

- Proficiency in writing as demonstrated by Personal Statement of the transfer application
- Co-curricular involvement
- Personal letter of recommendation

### **Tuition Assistance**

It is the goal of our administration that every young man who has the ability and desire to attend St. X be able to do so regardless of financial circumstances. With that said, there is a finite tuition assistance budget set aside for transfer applicants. Tuition assistance is awarded in the form of grants to students demonstrating need on the basis of family financial circumstances.
