Convent & Stuart Hall Dance Policy Guest Form

In order to ensure student safety at Convent & Stuart Hall dances, and to further mutual respect within the school, students must sign a dance pledge before attending their first dance of the year. Students follow the guidelines of the Student Handbook by their pledge, their respectful presence, and by their respect for all members of the community at the dance. Students' dress, behavior, and conduct at a school dance shows respect for self, others, time, and space.

GENERAL DANCE RULES

1. *All school rules are in effect during school dances.*
2. *Entrance and Departure*
 - a. Student accompanying Guest must sign their pledge before the dance.
 - b. Guests must bring their signed pledges to the dance with a School ID.
 - c. Guests must arrive at the designated dance time with the student accompanying them.
 - d. Guests may NOT leave the dance before doors are opened.
3. *Guest Policy* - Each student may bring only one guest and is responsible for the behavior of their guest. Students must accompany their guests and introduce their guest to the chaperone at the entrance to the dance. Guests must have their signed pledge at the entrance of the dance.
4. *Dress* - Students and guests are asked to use good judgment and to wear appropriate dress, avoiding excessively baggy and/or saggy pants and revealing clothing. The ultimate decision of appropriate dress will be by the chaperones, who may deny entrance to those who are deemed inappropriately dressed.
5. *Bags* - Backpacks, bags, and purses must be checked-in at coat check, and must be searched by the chaperone at coat check. Once checked at arrival, bags may only be accessed at the end of the dance.

RULES FOR DANCING

1. Students must be respectful towards all students, chaperones, and any others in attendance. Chaperones are the ultimate arbiters of judgment in this regard. Any redirection or correction from a chaperone must be heeded.
2. All dance styles must comply with standards of modesty and safety.
Dancing must not simulate sexual activity. "Mosh pit" style dancing is not permitted.

DRUG AND ALCOHOL USE

If an adult strongly suspects or has evidence that a student or guest is under the influence of drugs or alcohol, the dean or other administrator or faculty will remove the student from the dance. Parents and the Head of both Schools will be notified, and disciplinary action may result. Entrance may be delayed or denied should any chaperone suspect alcohol consumption.
