

EXTRACURRICULAR ELIGIBILITY

Participation in extracurricular activities is a privilege. Certain minimal expectations must be met in order to enjoy the full benefits of participation. These guidelines are intended to clarify for the students, parents, and teachers the minimal expectations for participation.

Disciplinary Conditions

- A student receiving a suspension from school may not participate in any after school events during the corresponding days of suspension.
- Students with repeated infractions at any level of the Student Code of Conduct may be subject to suspension from any after school activity.
- The length of any suspension will be determined on a case by case basis.

Academic Conditions

The process to determine eligibility will start the Monday following the 3rd week after the school year begins (September 15, 2014) and is reviewed every two weeks by the guidance department for the remainder of the school year. Eligibility is determined by following a three phase process in order to maximize opportunities for students to improve academic performance and retain full eligibility. Entry into the three phase process begins at the next two week checkpoint *if a student's grade in any course drops below a D- or when two grades drop below C-*.

Eligibility Phases

1. Warning
2. Probation
3. Ineligible

- **ACADEMIC WARNING**
 - Students who do not meet the minimum academic requirements (may not receive one F or two D's) are placed on academic warning for two weeks (phase 1).
 - Students on warning may attend all practices/rehearsals and games/performances.
 - Student and parents will be notified by the Athletic Director of this warning and will be required to verify they were notified by signing the Academic Warning Form.
 - Failure to sign does not change a student's status.
 - Student will be required to meet with the teacher(s) of the class(es) he/she is having difficulty with to discuss a pathway or create a plan for improvement.
 - At the end of the two week warning period :

- If the minimum academic requirements are met (may not receive one F or two D's) the teacher(s) will sign the Academic Warning Form and the student's name will be removed from the warning list.
 - If the minimum academic requirements are not met (may not receive one F or two D's) the student will be placed on academic probation (phase 2) for two weeks.
- **ACADEMIC PROBATION**
 - Students on probation may only attend practice or rehearsals but may NOT participate in games or performances).
 - may not be in uniform at games
 - may not travel with the team to away games
 - Student and parents will be notified by the Athletic Director of this probation and will be required to verify they were notified by signing the Academic Probation Form.
 - Failure to sign does not change a student's status.
 - Student will be required to meet with the teacher(s) of the class(es) he/she is having difficulty with to discuss a pathway or create a plan for improvement.
 - At the end of the two week probation period :
 - If the minimum academic requirements are met (may not receive one F or two D's) the teacher(s) will sign the Academic Probation Form and the student's name will be removed from the probation list.
 - If the minimum academic requirements are not met (may not receive one F or two D's) the student will be ineligible (phase 3) for at least two weeks.
- **INELIGIBILITY**
 - Ineligible students may not participate in any extracurricular activities (practices / games / rehearsals / performances)
 - Student and parents will be notified by the Athletic Director of this ineligibility and will be required to verify they were notified by signing the Academic Ineligibility Form.
 - Failure to sign does not change a student's status.
 - Student will be required to meet with the teacher(s) of the class(es) he/she is having difficulty with to discuss a pathway or create a plan for improvement.
 - At the end of the two week ineligibility period :
 - If the minimum academic requirements are met (may not receive one F or two D's) the teacher(s) will sign the Academic Ineligibility Form and the student's name will be removed from the ineligible list.
 - If the minimum academic requirements are not met (may not receive one F or two D's) the student will remain ineligible for at least two more weeks.
