WHAT DO I NEED TO REGISTER?

All families registering a new student with the Brockton Public Schools must bring the following required documents to the School Registration & Parent Information Center as part of their registration process. Applications cannot be processed without these documents.

- Official birth certificate or passport indicating parents' names (Copies are not accepted)
- Parent's/Guardian's valid picture I.D.
- Three documents that prove Brockton residency (see BPS Residency Policy below)
- Required Immunizations (Required Immunizations by grade level below)
- Proof of lead screening (for Kindergarten)
- Proof of vision screening with stereopsis
- Recent physical exam from doctor
- Individualized Education Plan (if child has been identified with special educational needs)
