Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Knowledge/operation of outdoor power equipment (mower/tractor, snow blower, edger/trimmer, tiller, etc)
- Performs ground maintenance by mowing, watering, sweeping and weeding
- Take necessary action to correct any mechanical, structural, or electrical condition in need of repair/replacement
- This position requires extensive standing, walking on flat and uneven terrain, driving, climbing stairs/ladders, squatting/kneeling, lifting/carrying up to 50 lbs, moving furniture and shoveling
- Interact positively with students, administrators, co-workers, parents and community
- Perform other duties as assigned

Employee Safety:

This employee is responsible for the use of safety devices and protective equipment in order to minimize the frequency and severity of work-related accidents. The employee is responsible for using safe practices and methods in the operation and supplies related to their job.

The employee is further responsible for correcting any conditions within the building or grounds that may be hazardous to employees, students, or staff assigned to the building and reporting same to the facilities supervisor or appropriate administrator.
