



The Big Picture With Fr. Bob



Dear Friends,

With the celebration of the Baptism of the Lord we conclude the Christmas season. I want to thank all of you for making my first Christmas at Divine Child so joyful, rewarding, and prayerful.

Thanks again for all the people who helped our Christmas season to be beautiful and welcoming for people who attended our Masses. I must admit I have never seen our church so beautiful! Beauty lifts our minds and hearts to God. I think that happened for many people who came to Divine Child during the Christmas season.

Tomorrow begins the liturgical season which we call "Ordinary Time." I must admit I wish we would come up with a better name for this liturgical season. After all, how can anyone who is a disciple of Jesus live an "ordinary life"?

Walking through life each day with Jesus should transform any ordinary day into an extraordinary day! When we are baptized, we become children of God filled with the Holy Spirit. At Confirmation, we receive an even deeper indwelling of the Holy Spirit into our soul. God equips us with what we need to be the light in the darkness.

Pope Benedict once said that the Word of God that we read in the Bible does not only tell us truths about God, but it makes things happen! God spoke and the world was created. God continues to create by creating in us a new heart. Let us not forget that when we reflect upon the Word of God, it makes things happen! If we help those who are struggling spiritually, emotionally, and physically, we will have in fact been the hands and eyes and mouth of Jesus. Let me conclude with a beautiful prayer by St. Teresa of Avila:

Compassion on this world.
Yours are the feet with which He walks to do good.
Yours are the hands with which He blesses all the world.
Yours are the hands,
Yours are the feet,
Yours are the eyes,

May this season of Ordinary Time be a time when Jesus works extraordinarily in each of our lives!





Thanks to Jodi Ann and the RCIA candidates and catechumens nearly 50 people prayed for the intentions of the families of our parish and council. Thank-you to all who stayed to pray with us!

The Nativity itself is credited to St. Francis of Assisi. It is believed that he created the first Nativity in the Italian city of Greccio on Christmas Eve 1223 where he celebrated Mass in a cave outside of town with a manger filled with hay and a live ox and donkey. Franciscans quickly spread the practice of creating nativity scenes with live animals and actors. As static replicas of the Nativity became more popular, the scene could be displayed for longer periods of time. The tradition grew to regions throughout the world where the participants in the scene looked less like biblical figures and more like characters from local villages. The popularity of Nativity scenes indicates that over the centuries people have been drawn to building their own Bethlehem. Setting up a Nativity scene not only allows us to remember and celebrate the birth of Our Lord, but also St. Francis who was so enthralled with his visit to the Holy Land that he brought that drama to life.

One of the most extensive Nativity scenes to be seen is collected and assembled by one of our own Foley Knights. **Pompeo Galasso** has been collecting Fontanini pieces for years to create his Nativity village. This labor of love takes up nearly a quarter of his living room! The tradition is now being shared with his grandson **Marco Thomson**, who helps him set up the complete village that surrounds the creche. Last weekend on the Feast of the Epiphany, Fr. Matt visited Rosa and Pompeo and the Nativity was blessed for the first time in all these years. Father also took the opportunity to bless their home, using only white chalk as not to mess with Pompeo's painted trim!

As the Christmas Season officially ends this weekend with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, we hope that your own Nativity took a place of precedence in your home. Merry Christmas!


