3. **Principal Report:**
 - Trish Miller reported on this Giving Tuesday, LHS is in the lead to win \$1,000 from the Arch Diocese.
 - \$8,000 in revenue was brought in from the Pop Up online Spirit Shop!
 - Semester exams will be held on Dec. 18, 19, 20.
 - Focus on College & Career Readiness ~ new support from LHS alum re: **career** readiness! Exciting new opportunity where alum can employ current LHS juniors and seniors, beginning next summer. Working through SOCHE, who will handle HR, liability, payroll, interviews, etc.
 - Building update: need \$3.5 million by Jan. Currently at \$3.3 million.
 - Update on “food after school” – yes, it will begin to be offered after the holiday break; items will be “Grab n’ Go” accessibility. Not sure yet if lunch cards will be able to be swiped, or cash only, etc.
 - Answer to pro-rated parking fee of \$50 for boys who do not begin driving until the spring: *NO, it is a \$50 parking fee, regardless of when a student begins driving to school, as this annual fee is used to repaint lines, and general upkeep of the school parking lot.*
 - LHS has reached out to prospective families regarding “failing” high schools and Edchoice. Now, administration is trying to determine how to inform current parents, as there are still many unanswered questions – re: who will qualify, for how much, etc. Stay tuned for updates as administration receives them. (Families can apply beginning February 1, 2020).
4. **The Craft Fair** seemed to be a success!
 - Thank you to Patti for spear-heading this undertaking
 - Early preliminary numbers suggest LPC brought in between \$10,000-\$11,000.
 - Meeting on Dec. 16 to debrief
 - Keep for next year? No one shadowed Patti this year to take over...
 - Will need to decide in early January in order to alert loyal crafters.

- If LPC decides to do something in lieu of the Craft Fair next year, Mike suggested we commit to doing that particular fundraiser for 3 years; first year, it sleeps, second year, it creeps, third year it “leaps”
