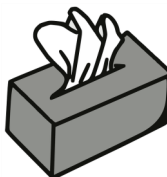
Buses

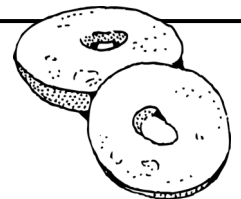
