

Chemistry 101-102 Dual Credit Enrollment Checklist

Prerequisites:

- Students must be in academic good standing. Students who have taken a JJC class prior to this time and has received a “D” or an “F” are not eligible to enroll in district dual credit classes.
- It is strongly suggested that students meet with their high school counselor to discuss schedule and review NCAA eligibility and transfer credit options where applicable.
- Students must meet JJC requirements for admission:
 - Math placement into Math 139 or 142
 - English placement into ENG 101
- A grade of C or better in Chemistry or Honors Chemistry.

Requirements:

- Complete and sign Academic Dual Credit Student Approval Form; submit to counselor.
- Apply to JJC online; submit printed completed application to counselor.

Notices:

- Costs of tuition, textbooks and other required materials will be the responsibility of the student and parents/guardians.
- Students will be dropped by JJC if payment is not made by the due date.
- Transportation is the responsibility and liability of the parents/guardians.
