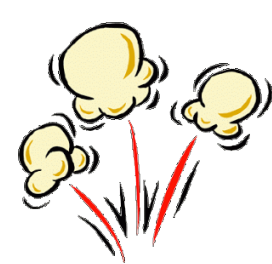
You can schedule your appointment online between January 17th starting at 6:00pm until January 26th ending at 11:59pm.
