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## General Information

- 1 Tryouts are for 4 Days, May 28<sup>th</sup> through 31<sup>st</sup> at Eagle Golf Camp.
- 2 Most team members have some golf background before joining the team, but students new to the game sometimes make the team.
- 3 We practice Monday through Thursday from 2:15 until about 5:00.
- 4 We play and practice year around, and there is a bus that provides transportation to any players that need a ride from the school to Eagle Pointe for practice everyday.
- 5 We have 4 teams. Varsity boys and girls, and junior varsity boys and girls. There are at least 5 players on each team.
- 6 The overall team size varies from year to year based on the number of returning players and overall skill level of those wishing to join.
- 7 Each team will play 8 tournaments. District, region, and state tournaments are Varsity only. We normally play 4 tournaments in the fall and another 4 in the spring for both JV and Varsity teams.
- 8 Players are expected to have their own clubs, but sometimes players borrow clubs from me or their parents.
- 9 It is possible to play golf and be in other extra-curricular activities, but it is not likely you will be a varsity player.
- 10 Team members are encouraged to play tournaments during the summer to gain experience and exposure to college coaches.
