### **Summer Transition Experience for Students with Autism**

#### **Eligibility:**

Adolescents and Young Adults aged 12-21 with Autism and currently enrolled in school.

#### **Program Focus:**

The primary focus of the program is to provide adolescents and young adults with Autism the skills they need to successfully transition to adulthood. Students will have hands on learning experiences that will include role playing, social stories, and peer and teacher modeling. This experience will include a number of integrated, natural settings to promote generalization of skills that are taught.

#### **Program Goals:**

- Social interaction skills
- Communication skills
- Self-Advocacy
- Career Exploration
- Goal Setting
- Life skills for independent living

Summer reports will be provided to parents and sending school districts.

**Program Dates:** July 6, 2020 - July 31, 2020 = 4 weeks

#### **Classes and Staffing:**

- Limit of 12 students per class
- Certified Special Education teachers
- Staffed with aides and volunteers
