

VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS FOR CLASS OF 2021

The Ohio Department of Health has revised the School Immunization Requirements effective December 3, 2015. Students now must be vaccinated against meningococcal disease (MCV4) *prior to entering their 12th grade school year.*

This means that your 11th grade student must provide the School Nurse with documentation of meningococcal vaccination *prior to the start of their senior year 2020-2021.*

To meet the requirements for the meningococcal vaccine, two doses are required. The second dose must be given after your student's 16th birthday. However, if your student receives their first meningococcal vaccine after their 16th birthday, then only one dose is required.

- ❖ To avoid exclusion at the start of the 2020-2021 school year, I am advising that as soon as your student receives the meningococcal vaccine (must be after age 16), that you provide the School Nurse with the documentation.
