OUTSIDE CREDIT DEADLINES

- **Northridge Learning Center:** Packets due May 8, 2020. They cost \$50 per 0.25 credit.
- **Utah Students Connect:** 4th term ends May 21, 2020. Final tests will be proctored at WXHS the last week of the term or can be scheduled at Northern Utah Testing Center. Call them at 801-402-5385 to make an appointment.
- **WXHS make-up packets (history only):** Due May 10, 2020.



CITIZENSHIP & FEES

You can't graduate with U's or outstanding fees!

- If you have U's talk to Mrs. Mason in the main office
- To see what fees you owe, see Mrs. Mills in main office
 - You can make a payment plan to break up payments

I'VE APPLIED...NOW WHAT?

- Accept admission and scholarships
- Check (and doublecheck) with college to make sure you've completed all required tasks – log into your college account often!
- Send final transcripts to the college you are attending (if required)
- If you are moving away to attend college, get housing!

NEED TO DEFER?

- You will need to defer admission and scholarships. Check with admission and financial aid offices at the college you will be attending.
- Consider granting permission for your parents to access your account in your absence. This can be done through college website and can always be changed later.

HONOR CORD APPLICATIONS

ACADEMIC HONOR CORDS ONLY:

GOLD: 3.75 GPA or higher

SILVER: 3.5 - 3.75 GPA

- Students who qualify for honor cords will receive a personal notice shortly after the end of third term of their senior year.
- The fee for academic honor cords is \$6 payable in the main office. The deadline for payment is April 15, 2020.

DEPARTMENTAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS will be recognized at senior awards night. Departmental honor cords have been discontinued. See website for more information and applications.
