### Agenda Items

#### Welcome

*Melanie Smith*

- November Meeting Minute Review
  - Council members reviewed meeting minutes. Melanie moved to approve, Chadli seconded.
- Updated Budget Review
  - Budget is on track for the year.

#### Remediation Update

- Council members discussed remediation results so far this year. There are only a few students who need to be remediated as the end of this term.

#### World Language

- Council members were not able to talk to the Language Department. We will revisit next month.

#### Digital Citizenship

- Council members listened to the report from Loren, then discussed the Council's responsibilities.
  - The State Board of Education has contracted with Digital Response-A-Bility for 5 years. We think this information needs to be more directly given to teachers as an available resource.
  - The District is doing a good job with their technology management systems. There are good firewalls and policies in place to prevent misuse of technology and appropriate consequences for those who do violate the policy.
  - We need to get the word out to more parents about the resources available to them. Links and information will be put in the weekly newsletter, as well as on the school website. Also discussed the possibility of putting up more information about the student groups offered by the Counseling Department and what curriculum is being used in those groups.
  - This topic will be revisited next month.
- Also charged Council Members with talking to their community members about what goals they think the school should have for next year. We will talk about this again later in the year.

## **SBG & Parent Survey Data**

- Council Members discussed the survey results on how Standards-Based Grading (SBG) is working so far. Overall grading average is up and there are fewer failing students. There are also less students receiving A's.
- Council members discussed how the Summit Learning program could help parents, students, and teachers know more about where students are in their learning and how to help them with remediation and enrichment. It might also address concerns with some SBG issues that came up from the surveys.
- Tricia Butler (parent council member) agreed to do a site visit at Farmington High School with teachers from Legacy Junior High. She will discuss what she learned and her recommendation with the Council at the next meeting in February.
