

**HOW TO SEW A PILLOWCASE** with Angela Wolf

# **Custom Pillowcase**

## Instructions

#### **CALCULATE THE FABRIC**

- To get the fabric dimensions, measure your pillow and add 1" to the width and 1" to the length for a seam allowance.
- 2. Add 10" to the length for the decorative flap.
- 3. Cut two pieces of fabric to these dimensions.

### PREPARE THE OPENING

- Using tailor's chalk, mark a line 1" from the edge.
  Then mark another line 6" from the edge. Repeat for the second piece of fabric.
- 2. Fold at the 6" mark toward the wrong side of the fabric and press. Then tuck under at the 1" mark and press. Repeat for the second piece of fabric.

#### **SEW THE PILLOWCASE**

- Unfold your fabric pieces.
- With right sides facing each other and all corners and fold lines matched up, pin the pillowcase pieces together along the three unfinished edges.
- Stitch around the three edges with a ½" seam allowance.
- Finish the seam allowances with a zigzag or overlock stitch.
- 5. Turn both pressed folds toward the wrong side of the fabric, making sure to line up the side seams, and pin. Stitch 1/8" away from the folded edge.
- 6. Turn the pillowcase to the right side. Fold the finished edge down 4" toward the right side of the pillow and press.
- Tack the side seams by stitching back and forth along the side seam line.
