## Services Include:

⇒ Classroom discussions.

⇒ Consultation with teachers, parents, doctors.

⇒ Developmental Guidance activities covering topics such as decision making, feelings, friendships, cooperation, conflict resolution, drug awareness, safety issues.

⇒ Emergency nursing services and maintenance of health plans, immunization records, and health records.

⇒ Exceptional educational needs assessment, which may include individual measurements of intellectual functioning, academic performance, social behavior, perceptual motor development, and adaptive behavior functioning.

⇒ Individual counseling concerning social and personal issues.

⇒ In-service for parents and school staff

⇒ Post high school planning

⇒ Public health services, disease prevention, health promotion

⇒ Screening and assessments for academic, social, and emotional needs

⇒ Small group work, such as new student groups, family change groups, friendship groups, social skills groups.

**Student Response Team (SRT)** is a problem solving group where teachers, and other staff meet to discuss student needs. The team assists with...

⇒ Reviewing information and discussing alternatives for working with students in regular education.

⇒ Clarifying concerns about students and brainstorming ideas.

⇒ Meeting with parents, teachers and other support personnel about student needs.

⇒ Coordinating the efforts of school staff in meeting student needs.
