

Pupils Dress Code

Pupils are expected to wear School uniform as detailed in this booklet, and as appropriate to their gender, throughout the School working day.

The following points have been clarified in consultation with the School Council.

Pre-Prep and Prep:

Shoes	Black leather – ‘Vans’ type shoes or black trainers are not acceptable.
	Low heels and no ballet pumps.
Socks	Trainer socks are not permitted.
Inclement weather	Coats - Mount Kelly Navy Blue Coat (Nursery - Year 8) Alternatively, pupils in Years 7 and 8 may wear the official Mount Kelly coat (Helly Hansen). A link to the online order form will be sent out in due course.
Make-up/Nail Varnish	Pupils are not permitted any form of make-up or nail varnish.
Hair	Long hair must be tied back.
	Hair bands/Alice bands should be neutral in colour or in the school colours.
	Hair should not be heavily styled, differ dramatically in length, or cut shorter than a grade 2.
Jewellery/Piercings	Pupils may wear a watch, a single bracelet or charity band.
	Necklaces are not permitted.
	Pupils are not allowed pierced ears until Year 7.
	In Years 7 and 8, ear studs are permitted but not earrings.
	Multiple earrings and ear studs are not permitted.
	Pupils may not wear any other piercing.
Bags	Pupils must have a Mount Kelly rucksack (Prep) or book-bag (Pre-Prep) and a Mount Kelly games bag.

Pupils Dress Code - College:

Shoes	Black leather or suede – ‘Vans’ type shoes are not acceptable.
Socks	Low heels and no ballet pumps.
Tights	Girls are to wear black ankle-length socks.
Inclement weather	With summer skirts girls may wear black tights or black ankle-length socks.
	Pupils may not wear hats of any sort.
Trousers	Jeans are not to be worn as a substitute for School trousers.
	Trousers are not to be excessively tight-fitting.
Make-up/Nail Varnish	Pupils in Years 9 – 11 may wear small amounts of discrete foundation or concealer, but may not wear any other make-up, mascara or nail varnish. False eyelashes may not be worn.
	Pupils in Years 12 – 13 may wear make-up in moderation, and nail varnish which is discrete and in keeping with the uniform. False eyelashes may not be worn.
Hair	Pupils in Years 9 – 11 - long hair must be tied back.
	Pupils in Years 12 – 13 may wear their hair down, but it must be tidy.
	Hair should not be heavily styled, differ dramatically in length, or cut shorter than a grade 2.
Jewellery/ Piercings	Pupils may wear a watch, a single, discrete necklace, a single bracelet or charity band.
	A single set of unobtrusive earrings or ear studs are permitted.
	Multiple earrings and ear studs are not permitted.
	Pupils may not wear any other piercing.
Tattoos	Tattoos are strongly discouraged, and should certainly not be visible.
Sports-wear around School	Whilst moving about the School, prior to or immediately after games, swimming training or PE, pupils are to wear either a full Mount Kelly tracksuit or Mount Kelly tracksuit bottoms with a Mount Kelly hoodie or polo shirt.
	Skin-tight leggings are not to be worn around the School during the School day under any circumstances.
Headphones	Headphones are neither to be worn nor visible when moving around School.
