


Year 3" 'Rocks and Soils' topic

IGCSE offer 2020 for Year 9 Parents



- DTP (diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis)
- IPV (polio)
- MMR (mumps, measles, rubella)
- Chickenpox

Children from 12 to 14 years:

• HPV (human Papillomavirus)

Children from 11 to 18 years need the following boosters:

- MMR
- DTP
- IPV

Please ask your family doctor if you have any questions and bring in copy of updated vaccines.
