The Foundation selects unfunded school projects, and through fundraisers, corporate and private contributions, and state and local government support, has been able to financially support many initiatives including the Capstone Collaborative Learning Studios and Applied Technology Lab at Palos South, playground renewals at Palos East and Palos West, iPads for student use, and much more.

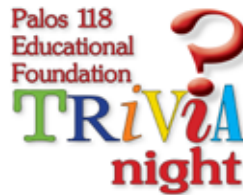
## ANNUAL FOUNDATION FUNDRAISING EVENTS

All you have to do is mention our fundraiser or show our flyer. More details will be revealed as the school year approaches.

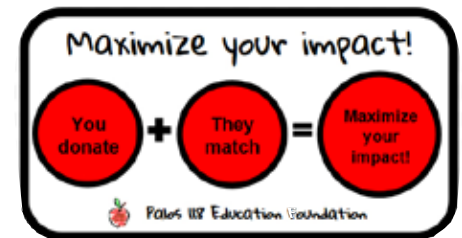
