If additional bad weather closings require that the school add more days to the calendar, the following days may be added: March 22nd (2nd Monday of Spring Break), April 5th Monday (Professional Day) and/or May 31st (Memorial Day Observed).

CALENDAR 2020-2021

Our school calendar, in conjunction with calendars at Bryn Mawr and RPCS, is based on the following assumptions:

1. School will generally begin on the Wednesday before Labor Day except when in conflict with a religious holiday or to achieve the requisite number of days (School will begin on Tuesday for the 2020-2021 school year).
2. Commencement for Roland Park Country School and Bryn Mawr will be held on a Tuesday in June. Gilman's graduation will be on the preceding Saturday, we typically allow for approximately 174 academic days, but no fewer than 172.
3. Winter and spring breaks aim to provide a combined total of approximately three school weeks of vacation.
4. We will provide three- and one-half professional development days during the school year: one and a half days in the fall and one day each in winter and spring.
5. The school will be closed for the first day of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur when these holidays fall on a weekday. We will close for the Wednesday before Thanksgiving, The School will also be closed to observe Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birthday, President's Day, Good Friday, and Memorial Day, observed.
