General Information

What is I/E?

The Intervention and Enrichment or I/E Period is a 40-minute span of time between period 3 and 5. A large variety of non-graded enrichment options are offered for students varying from club meetings, discovery opportunities, and brain break courses like 3D Printing, Cinematography, Fantasy Sports and many more. However, some I/E Period offerings might be required for students as an intervention step to aide them in their academic courses; otherwise, students can pick 6 different I/E Periods per semester

The Enrichment options will be selected by students, at the beginning of each semester. At times throughout the school year, I/E Period may be used to have meetings with classes to share important information like graduation requirements, as to not take away from academic or core classes.

Picking Your Courses

When picking your I/E courses every student should be following the general rule of 3 and 3. Students should evaluate the department grids that are outlined in the book and plan to take 3 fun I/E's and 3 academic I/E's (Direct Studies). As we move forward with the process, new protocols have been added:

1. Students are not allowed to sign up for multiple sections of the same I/E unless it is a directed study.
2. Some courses have prerequisites that will be strictly adhered to.
3. Failure to pick your courses will result in administration force scheduling a set of I/E classes for you. Please take the time to pick your own.
4. If you are a WMCTC student, please understand the time constraint associated WMCTC and your selections should not interfere with your participation and the participation of other students in that I/E.
5. These are scheduled classes. All school protocols are in effect even though I/E is not graded.
6. Students receiving a D or F in a course will be required to report to the corresponding directed study for that same course. For example, if a student is receiving a D in Algebra 1, he or she will be expected to report to the Algebra 1 Directed Study intervention during the 40 minute time slot.
