- The SFN has posted scholarships for the Class of 2020 and candidates are now able to apply online. All scholarship offerings are listed at sf-ns.org. Please view the scholarships and apply by February 3, 2020! Applicants only need to apply to one scholarship and their application will automatically be sent to other SFN scholarships if the student fits the criteria of a different scholarship.
 - You may also be asked to submit an "unofficial transcript" along with the application. To request a transcript for this, PLEASE SIGN UP ON THE CLIPBOARD AT THE FRONT COUNTER OF THE COUNSELING OFFICE and include your email address! We will then email you a copy of your transcript to upload to your application. If you miss this step, your application will be deemed incomplete and won't be considered for the scholarship.
