The Board also took action to approve 2014-15 UCC/ Woolley Center Alt Ed Agreement; the Durham

Transportation Contract Extension; and Meal Prices and Annual Student Fees for 2014-15. Policy GAA:Personnel:Definitions was adopted. The Board discussed the RHS gym roof and proposed modular for Eastwood School. The Board approved the recommendation to partner with Cascade Technology Alliance (CTA) for Synergy support for the 2014-15 school year. A proposal to restructure the Transportation and Purchasing Departments was also approved. A proposed Memorandum of Understanding for Childcare Provider Pay was approved, along with a Classified Vacation Use and Accrual change.
