Report: Dr. Parsons shared a 2014-15 Student Enrollment Report, noting that 570,857 Oregon students enrolled in K-12 public schools last fall. Of the 197 districts, 58% saw enrollment increase, 41% had a decrease, and 1% saw no change. Judges are still needed for the Hucrest Science Night on April 2nd. Action Items: The School Board took action to approve the Con-

sent Agenda that included minutes from the January 28th Regular Board Meeting. Board Policy GCA: License Requirements, was approved for Second Reading and Adopted. Policy LBE: Public Charter Schools, was approved for First Reading and Adopted.

Board Chairman, Rod Cotton, announced that 16 individuals including 3 community members, 4 administrative staff, 3 classified, 3 licensed, 1 confidential and two union representatives will comprise the 2015 superintendent screening committee. The names will be forwarded to Greg McKenzie, Window to Leadership consultant, who will be in communication with the group with further instructions.

The board adopted Resolution 14-15-17 declaring March 2-6, 2015 as Classified Employee Appreciation Week. Chair Cotton stated that these employees are very important to the organization, working extremely hard alongside teachers and administrators.
