School Board Work Session:

Board members met with OSBA Events and Executive Search Specialist Donna Herren to begin discussion of the upcoming superintendent search process following Dr. Larry Parsons' announcement at the previous board meeting of his intention to retire at the conclusion of the 2014-15 school year.

Action Items:

The Board approved the minutes from the September 10, 2014, Board Meeting, as well as a proposed list of surplus items.

The Board took action to approve Policy IIA: Instructional Resources / Instructional Materials for First Reading.

Teaching & Learning Administrative Coordinator Jill Weber presented a Division 22 Compliance Update—Health Education Biennial Review.

Jill shared that she recently facilitated a meeting with local community members that included educators and parents, along with physicians and representatives from the County Health Department. They gathered together to review health education curriculum following

significant changes to OAR 581-022-1440 (3) that impacts our curriculum in the area of human sexuality.

Following the Division 22 update, Policy IGAI: Human Sexuality, AIDS/HIV, Sexually Transmitted Diseases, Health Education was approved for First Reading.

The proposed updates to this policy will align our instruction with the Oregon Health Education Standards and Benchmarks.

Board Members also approved Policy JECB: Admission of Non-Resident Students for First Reading.
